# Flower Burst Granny Square





15th August is the annual Granny Square Day, hosted by Simply Crochet Magazine, celebrating all things granny square.

This pattern is my 2023 contribution to this day.

# Materials

I used seven different shades of thin seaweed yarn, that were hand-dyed by Adelle of Vegan Yarn UK. Please visit www.veganyarn.co.uk to see the full range.

- · 4ply yarn (or that of your preference)
- · 4mm hook (or that of your preference)
- Scissors
- Needle for weaving in ends

# Gauge

Gauge is not important for this pattern. Please use whatever yarn and hook size that you would like to, bearing in mind that this will change the size of your resulting granny square.

#### Stitches

This pattern is written using UK crochet terms. If you prefer to use US terms, please see the US terms version that is also available.

ch ~ chain

dc ~ double crochet (US single crochet)

htr ~ half treble crochet (US half double crochet)

tr ~ treble crochet (US double crochet)

BS ~ bean stitch (description opposite)

yo ~ yarn over

sl st ~ slip stitch

sp ~ space

st ~ stitch

sk ~ skip

2tog - crochet number (indicated before tog) of stitches together using the stitch indicated before the number eg. tr2tog

#### Bean Stitch (BS)

Yo, insert hook into st, pull up loop, yo, insert into same stitch and pull up loop, yo, insert into same stitch and pull up loop, yo and draw through all loops (you will have 7 loops on your hook to draw through).

#### Stacked htr

Chl. Make a dc into the st, then dc into the left leg (or right leg if left-handed) of the dc, creating a stacked st.

### Standing stitches (tr)

For example, the tr is made by holding the loop on the hook (this is the loop created by the slip knot), wrapping the yarn around the hook, then inserting into the st, yo and pull up a loop, yo and pull through 2 loops. Yo and pull through remaining loops. The last loop will be the slip knot loop you made.

## Pattern

All rounds are worked right side up until the last round. We change colour every round.

Magic ring.

Round I: Chl (does not count as a st), 8dc into the ring. SI st to first dc to join. (8dc)

Fasten off. Change colour.

Round 2: Join new colour to any dc. (BS, ch2) around. SI st to first BS to join. (8BS, 8x ch2 sp).

Fasten off. Change colour.







Round 3: Standing tr into any ch2 sp. Tr, ch2, 2tr into the same ch2 sp. Tr into the top of the BS, tr into ch2 sp, tr into the top of the next BS.

((2tr, ch2, 2tr) into the ch2 sp. Tr into the top of the BS, tr into ch2 sp, tr into the top of the next BS) repeat 3 times. Sl st to the standing tr to join.

(28tr, 4x ch2 sp).

Fasten off. Change colour.





Round 4: Standing tr into any ch2 sp. Tr, ch2, 2tr into the same ch2 sp. (Ch1, sk lst, BS) 3 times. Ch1. ((2tr, ch2, 2tr) into the ch2 sp. (Ch1, sk lst, BS) 3 times. Ch1.) repeat 3 times. Sl st to the standing tr to join. (12BS, 12tr, 4x ch2 sp, 16x ch1 sp). Fasten off. Change colour.

Round 5: Standing tr into any ch2 sp. Tr, ch2, 2tr into the same ch2 sp. Ch2. Tr2tog over the next 2 chl sp. Chl. (Tr2tog in the chl sp just used, and the next chl sp, chl) twice. Chl. ((2tr, ch2, 2tr) into the ch2 sp. Ch2. Tr2tog over the next 2 chl sp. Chl. (Tr2tog in the chl sp just used, and the next chl sp, chl) twice. Chl.) repeat 3 times. Sl st to the standing tr to join. (12tr2tog, 12tr, 12x ch2 sp, 4x chl sp). Fasten off. Change colour.





Round 6: Standing tr into any ch2 sp. Tr, ch2, 2tr into the same ch2 sp. Ch3, 2tr into the top of each of the 3 tr2tog. Ch3. ((2tr, ch2, 2tr) into the ch2 sp. Ch3, 2tr into the top of each of the 3 tr2tog. Ch3.) repeat 3 times. Sl st to the standing tr to join. ((2tr2tog, 40tr, 4x ch2 sp, 8x ch3 sp). Fasten off. Change colour.

\*Turn to work on the wrong side.\*

Round 7: Stacked htr into any ch2 corner sp. 3htr into the same ch2 sp. Htr into the next 2tr. 3htr into the ch3 sp. Htr into the next 6tr. 3htr into the ch3 sp. Htr into the next 2tr.

(4htr into the ch2 sp. Htr into the next 2tr. 3htr into the ch3 sp. Htr into the next 6tr. 3htr into the ch3 sp. Htr into the next 2tr) repeat 3 times. SI st to the stacked htr to join.

(80htr)

Fasten off.

Sew in all ends and your granny square is complete.
